4.13 Loading custom functions at startup

This article covers the use of file commands in WS Office to interact with external files through custom functions. These functions, including `copyFile`, `renameFile`, and `selectFile`, require the `WSOffice.dll` to be installed on the target system and should be stored in a central location, such as the `elogan.sjs` file.

The `elogan.sjs` file, provided by Synactive, is read at login, making the functions within it globally available. This file must be stored in the script directory to be read and can be loaded using the **load** command.

[copyFile](#): Copies the contents of one file to another.

[renameFile](#): Renames a file using a custom function.

[selectFile](#): Allows the user to choose a file.

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
